

Manners for Dancers

Dancers show respect for themselves by:

- Being prompt for class
- Being dressed properly for class
- Having hair pulled back tightly
- Not wearing their dance shoes outside

Dancers show respect for others by:

- Keeping their hands to themselves during class
- Waiting quietly for others to have a turn and for instructions from the teacher
Talking with one another only during share time (pre/beg classes)

Dancers show respect for their teacher and the art of dance by:

- Being properly dressed and ready for class on time
- Listening when the teacher speaks
- Always asking before leaving the room for any reason and upon returning entering quietly
- Always finishing every exercise, never walking off noisily or showing anger or aggravation.

Dancers show respect for the studio by:

- Leaving gum, food, or drinks outside
- Never hanging or leaning on the Barre
- Never running or doing gymnastics in the lobby or parking lot
- Putting trash in its proper place
- Always keeping all belongings zipped inside their dance bag

Parents show respect for the dance class, teacher and studio by:

- Not entering dance room while class is in session
- Making sure child has had the opportunity to go to restroom before entering class
- Having students ready for class before entering the classroom
- Having students at class on time and picking them up promptly after class
- Letting us know in advance if possible if a student will be absent
- **Making arrangements with their child's teacher to make up missed classes**
- **Clearly marking all of their child's items with the child's name and leaving toys at home.**
- Teaching children to never run or scream in the studio, waiting room area, store, or parking lot.
- Being extremely cautious while driving in parking lot and not creating parking spots.
